



Belco Community Credit Union 2019 Scholarship Application

Belco Community Credit Union Scholarships were established to provide educational funds for members who are graduating high school seniors and those who are continuing their education.

Belco prides itself on serving members from childhood through adulthood, and that includes these very difficult and expensive years. To relieve some of the financial pressures associated with the growing cost of tuition, Belco is accepting applications.

Scholarship Amount

Belco will award five—\$1,000 scholarships: three to graduating high school seniors and two are awarded to members who are continuing their education.

Deadline

The completed application and all documentation must be postmarked by **March 1**.

Eligibility Requirements

Belco requires the following:

- Applicants must be a member of Belco in good standing
- Applicants must be a graduating high school senior or a college student
- Applicants must have a minimum 2.5 cumulative GPA

Applicants Must Submit:

1. A credit union essay of 300-500 words. The essay question will be on the scholarship application. The question will change from year to year. Please do not put your name on your essay.

How do I get an application?

- a. Ask any Member Service Representative for a scholarship application.
 - b. Call (800) 642-4482 and ask for an application to be sent to you.

2. A completed application.
 3. Include a typed list of school, work, civic and other activities. (Include awards, honors, work experience, civic and social activities that you are involved in throughout the year. Please do not include your work resume.)
 4. Provide proof of college admittance.
 5. Copy of High School Report Card or College Transcript

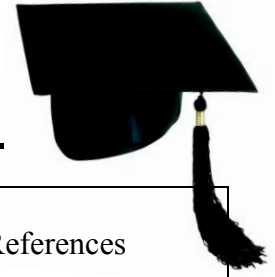
Awarding of Scholarships
